The reach to Lappock saw the boats stick largely to their starting sequence however after the tight reach to Beechams Hunters Moon closed in on Spanker to gain an overlap and overhaul Jamie.

Astern of this the battle for line honours and the evening win was taking place between Petra and Storm. Despite Gary Muir and crews best efforts Storm gained the upper hand on the Lappock to Beechams leg. Storm passed Petra on that tight reach to Beechams bouy. Both boats one tacked back to Troon resulting in a very close finish with only 20 seconds separating the two on corrected time with Storm taking victory and Petra a very close second.



The battle for the remaining podium place for the evening was equally hard fought. It was a three way split between Penn Player, Hunters Moon and Lysa Blue. Ultimately penn Player managed to pull away up the beat to give a buffer of 29 seconds between her and Lysa Blue who only snuck in by 4 seconds on corrected infront of Hunters Moon.
